# Right to Compensation

A road crash can change everything in seconds.



But the law is clear:  
you have a **RIGHT** to compensation  
in case of severe injury or death.

No Insurance



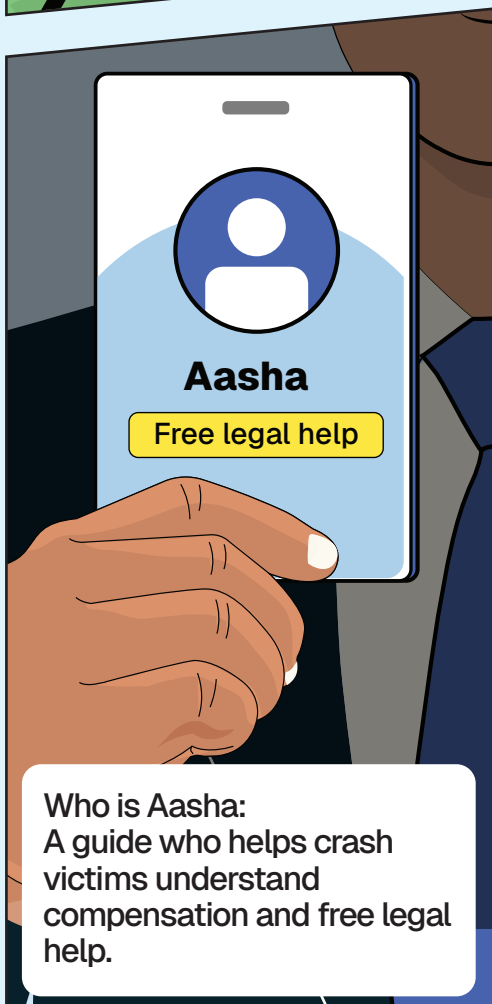
Fault not established

# Hit and Run – When Does It Apply



Hit and Run Accidents

- Driver or vehicle fled
- Vehicle not identified even after police investigation

If the vehicle is identified later, compensation shifts to Section 164 or No-Fault.

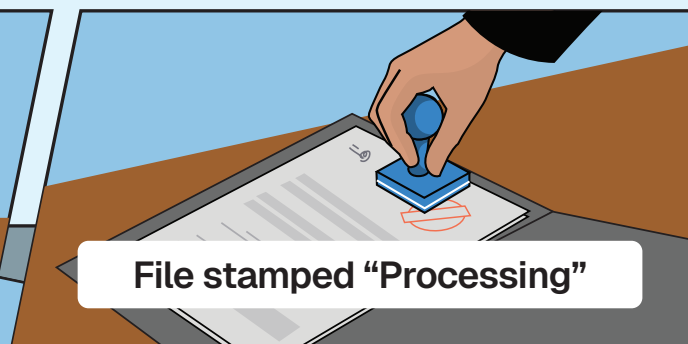
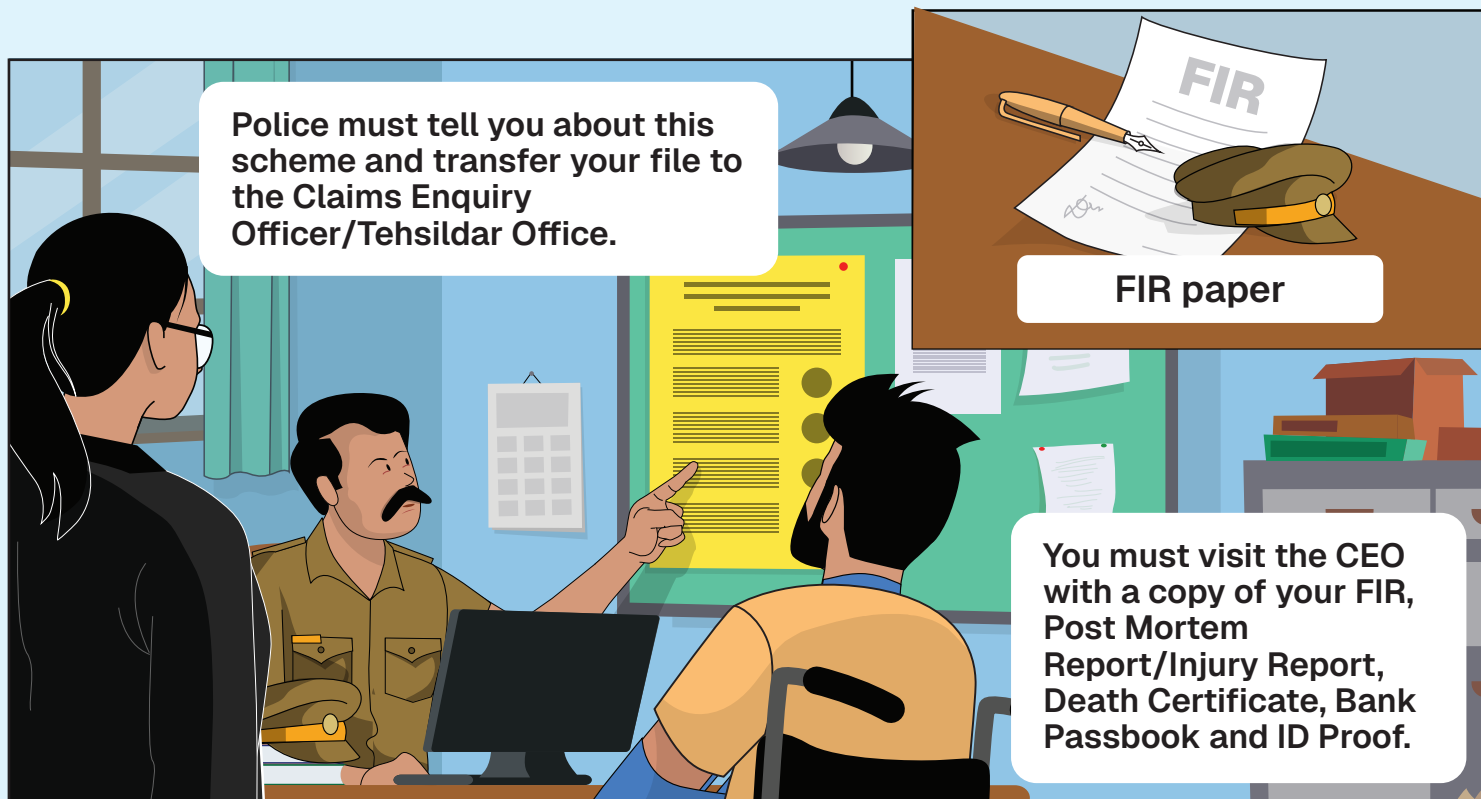

# Hit and Run Compensation Amounts

- ₹2,00,000: In Case of Death
- ₹50,000: For Grievous Injuries

# No-Fault Compensation Section 164

No need to prove who caused the accident. Just file a claim with the Motor Accidents Claim Tribunal (MACT).

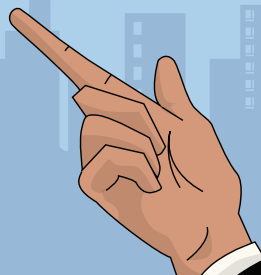


# Section 164: Fixed Relief Amounts

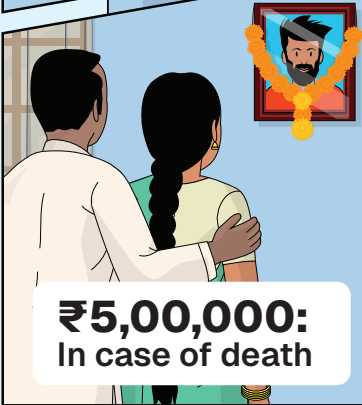
**₹2,50,000:**  
For grievous injury



This is immediate relief.  
You don't need to wait  
for a long court fight.



**₹5,00,000:**  
In case of death



The system is meant to  
support victims quickly,  
without stress or confusion.



You can still apply later for higher  
compensation under Section 166  
once evidence or fault is proven

Section 164 gives you  
quick support —  
Section 166 lets you  
seek compensation  
for all losses.



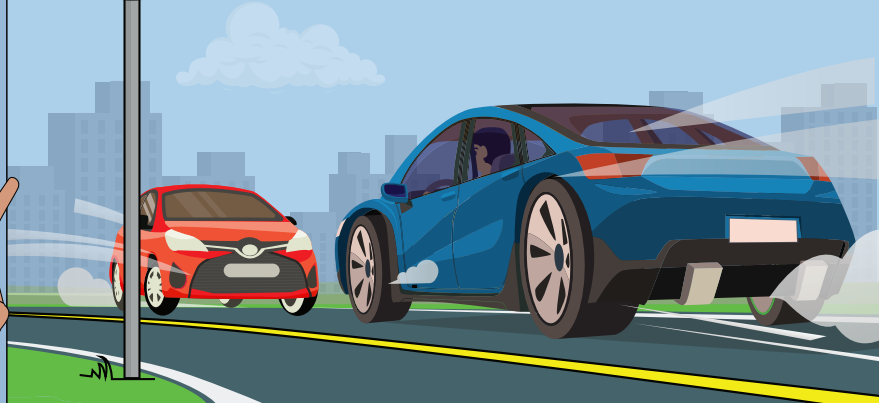
# MACT Claims: Essential Documents

When the crash clearly happened due to someone else's negligence...



Serious injury or loss of the main earner — these are situations for full compensation.

Section 166 helps you recover more — for medical costs, income loss, and emotional suffering.
